

Beanie Pattern

8 ply wool or acrylic.

Using 3.25mm Needles, cast on 115 stitches

Work 19 rows Knit 2. Paul 2

Change to 4.00mm needles.

Using either garter or stocking stitch continue until work measures 19cm from the band.

Next row: Knit 5 stitches together * Knit 5 together, rep from * to last 5 stitches, Knit 5 together. You should have 23 stitches.

Break off yarn and run end through remaining stitches. Draw up firmly and fasten off securely.

Sew up.

This is just a guide feel free to use your own pattern and size.

If you are doing the scarf and beanie to match the jumper, please adjust it to the size of your finished jumper.

Scarf.

For the scarf you can knit it in stocking, garter, rib stitch or any stitch of your choice. It should be a minimum of 13cm wide and about a meter long, if it is wider or longer don't worry, children come in all sizes.

Blanket.

Knitted or crocheted blankets, measuring approximately 1.5 metre square, would also be a wonderful gift for a vulnerable child.
